CITIES OVER ONE MILLION POPULATION WITH ONLY ONE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Asia Pacific cities listed below suffice with one international airport while having populations exceeding 1 million people. A number of these locations have opened new airports in the last 10 years and in all cases the previous international airports were reduced to domestic travel only.

Adelaide	1.1m	
Bangkok	10m	Prior to opening of new highway, it could take up to 3 hours to get to the airport.
Brisbane	1.76m	
Hanoi	3.5m	Airport situated 45kms from city
Hong Kong	7m	
Kuala Lumpur	1.4m	The airport is approximately 35 miles (55km) south of Kuala Lumpur. Travel time is 60 minutes.
Los Angeles	10m	Several airports but only one International airport
Madras	5m	
Manila	11.3m	
Melbourne	3.6m	20min bus link to city Nearest housing 7km from airport. Buses every 10-15 mins during the day. When it opened in 1970 it was in the countryside.
Mumbai	16m	Chattrapathi Shivaji Airport 35 kms from city centre
New Delhi	14m	
Perth	1.46m	Closest housing 4km from airport
Singapore	4.4m	No approaches over housing – all over the sea.
Tokyo – Narita	12m	Situated 65 kms from Tokyo
Sydney	4.1m	Plans cancelled for a new airport at Badgery Creek 51km from Sydney due to protests from local community.
